## ENFIELD RANGERS 6-A-SIDE SUMMER TOURNAMENT SATURDAY 16th JULY & SUNDAY 17th JULY 2011

### TOURNAMENT RULES

- 1 Clubs must be affiliated to their associated County FA and have a county affiliation number. Clubs must have a registered Welfare Officer.
- 2 Each squad will consist of a maximum of 9 members, 6 players and 3 substitutes.
- 3 Normal mini soccer rules will apply as follows:  
No off side, normal throw-ins & corners, goal keeper must not pick up back pass, goal kicks taken from any part of the area, 5 yard distance when free kick is awarded.
- 4 If there is a colour clash, the second named team will change or wear bibs.
- 5 If a team fails to turn up, all other teams in the group will be awarded 1-0 win and the 3 points.
- 6 Teams must be ready to play at the times noted in the fixture list. If a team fails to arrive without notification within five minutes of the game, a 1-0 win and the 3 points will be awarded to their opponents.
- 7 Match balls will be provided by Enfield Rangers Youth Football Club.
- 8 All games will start with the toss of a coin. The winning team will choose which end to play from and kick off.
- 9 League games will consist of 10 minutes one way.
- 10 In league games, 3 points will be awarded for a win, 1 point for a draw and 0 points for loss.
- 11 If teams are equal on points, goal difference will apply. If teams are equal on points and goal difference, then goals scored will apply. If still equal then a sudden death penalty shoot-out will determine the outcome.
- 12 The top two teams from each group will qualify for the quarter-final stage with the winners from group A playing the runners-up from group B and the winners from group B playing the runners-up from group A etc.
- 13 Quarter/semi-final games will consist of 12 minutes one way.
- 14 The final will consist of 8 minutes each way and 3 minutes for half time.
- 15 If the result of a quarter/semi-final and/or final is a draw, 3 minutes extra time will apply. If after after time the game is still drawn, each team will take 5 penalties out of the players left on the field. If after the 5 penalties the game is still drawn, then sudden death will apply starting with the remaining squad members including the substitutes.
- 16 Maximum playing time for players is as stated below:  
Under 7's and under 8's     **40 minutes**  
Under 9's and under 10's   **60 minutes**
- 17 Foul and abusive language by players, coaches/managers and/or parents will not be tolerated and the team will be excluded from the tournament. Please remember that we are in a respect campaign and everyone should enjoy the tournament.
- 18 Spectators (parents, friends & family) **MUST** observe the football matches from behind the crowd barriers. This is part of the Respect Campaign.
